



Introducing the Solution Kit!

Dear Families,

An important part of kindergarten readiness is having strong social-emotional skills. This includes knowing how to solve common social problems. Our classroom uses a tool called the *Solution Kit* that helps teach children to recognize a situation as a problem and then try different solutions. These visuals are available in our room as reminders.

The solution kit also comes in a home version with additional solutions relevant to situations that may occur at home. We have included a copy of the family solution kit with this letter.

You can support your child's learning at home by:

- Posting the family solution kit handout somewhere visible (e.g., on the refrigerator, on the child's bedroom door, etc.) and talking about what the different solutions are and what they mean.
- Pointing out when you are faced with a problem—any problem—and what solution you choose. For example, if you run out of paper towels, say out loud, "Oh no, I have a problem; I need a paper towel and there aren't any. What should my solution be?" Invite your child to help you come up with what you should do next. Doing this will help them learn the thought process for problem solving.
- Using the words "**problem**" and "**solution**" frequently to help your child become more familiar with those terms.

¡Les presentamos el kit de soluciones!

Queridas familias:

Una parte importante de la preparación para el jardín de infantes es el desarrollo de las habilidades socioemocionales, que consisten, entre otras cosas, en saber resolver situaciones sociales cotidianas. En el aula, utilizamos un recurso llamado el Kit de soluciones, para promover que los niños identifiquen un problema y prueben distintas soluciones. Estas imágenes se muestran en el aula a modo de recordatorio.

El kit de soluciones también viene en versión familiar con distintas soluciones que se adaptan a las situaciones que pueden ocurrir en casa. Junto con esta carta, les enviamos una copia del kit de soluciones para la familia.

Algunas maneras de promover el aprendizaje en casa:

- Exhibir el kit de soluciones para la familia en un lugar visible (p. ej. en el refrigerador, en la puerta de la habitación del niño, etc.) y conversar acerca de cuáles son las posibles soluciones y qué significan.
- Conversar sobre cualquier problema que se le presente y la solución que eligió. Por ejemplo, si se terminan las toallas de papel, pueden decir "Ay, no, tengo un problema; necesito toallas de papel y no hay ni una sola. ¿Cuál puede ser la solución?" Animen a los niños a proponer soluciones. Hacer esto los ayudará a desarrollar pensamiento crítico para la resolución de problemas
- Utilizar las palabras "**problema**" y "**solución**" a menudo para que el niño se familiarice con los términos.






